

Deep Thoughts in Deep Water

My first fishing foray this spring was to a stream near Deadwood in early April. It didn't dawn on me until I got up there that all the snow I'd been happily skiing on all winter at Terry Peak—was now melting and careening downhill!

I left without catching anything because the wily trout were in too deep and fast of water for my limited fishing skills. I actually said to myself that the stream looked like the big Poudre Canyon River in Colorado!

But as often happens on my fishing trips—I got to pondering theological questions—and this time it involved our streams of faith. Currently in America, we have four such streams—all with biblical grounding—but not all the same:

- 1. **Evangelical:** This faith stream has a lot to do with the heart. How it feels and what it means. We need Jesus in our hearts to strengthen, comfort and help us in life. Such faith helps keep us from being blinded by success and holds us up in times of failure.
- 2. **Mainline:** This stream focuses on justice. That means critiquing our capitalistic system and other modern concerns, and focusing on the common good.
- 3. **Reformed:** The water running in this stream comes out of Calvinism. No neutrality— everything we do has to represent a certain set of beliefs about human nature, God, right and wrong. What's important is we transform our work by coming at it from a Christian world view.
- 4. **Lutheran:** Our Lutheran stream's headwaters are in The Heidelberg Dispensation, which Martin Luther wrote at the beginning his career. In writing this, he tried to answer the questions of the church fathers who were asking about his progressive teachings. In paragraphs 1920 and 21 he wrote: "That person does not deserve to be called a theologian who looks upon the invisible things of God as though they were clearly perceptible in those things which have actually happened." Then Luther goes on to say: "He clearly deserves to be called a theologian, however, who comprehends the visible and manifested things of God seen through suffering and the cross. A theologian of glory calls evil good and good evil, a theologian of the cross calls the thing for what it actually is."

For Luther, and by extension us, the only way to understand what God's power really looks like is to look at the cross! Pretty deep thoughts for a simple fisherman—but it is a stream that I can fish in now—and forever!

The Grace Lutheran Women will be collecting a Love Offering for the women of the shelter.


Any personal care items are welcome, but this month the shelter is in need of hair conditioner and liquid laundry detergent.
