WORSHIP COMMITTEE MINUTES – MARCH 21, 2023

The Worship Committee met at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 21, 2023. In attendance were Pastor Carla Nelson, Pastor Kevin Jensen, Marcia Potts, Robin Baldwin, Ruth Mechling, and Marlene Kotab. After an opening prayer, the agenda was amended. Old Business:

- Palm Sunday plans were reviewed. The adult and children's choirs will sing after the
 procession of palms. We will use the liturgy from 2022 with a variety of readers including the
 congregation. Possible readers are Debbie Haivala, Melissa Pankratz, Tim Patmore, and
 Pastor Kevin. Pastor Carla will preach the sermon. We will ask Keri and Tessa Gunderson
 about sending out a message or a card to the congregation informing them of all the events for
 Holy Week.
- The Easter Cantata is April 2 and 4 with receptions following each performance.
- The Maundy Thursday Confirmands' Living Last Supper will be followed by the stripping and draping of the altar area.
- Plans are in place for the HS youth's presentation of the Reverse Advent. Rehearsal will be Wed., April 5 at 7:00. Musicians will be Dan, Danilee, Candy, and Marcia. Easter lilies will be brought up after the service. We will ask Dan and Lynelle Chapman to help with the decorating.
- Easter services 6:30 am and 9:00 am with breakfast served by Patmores and helpers from 7:30-8:30 am. Tim Patmore will run the sound. Musicians will be Dan, Danilee, Candy, and Marcia.
- No action on the altar cloth storage area.

New Business:

- Good Friday Crosswalk Grace will have the last two words of Christ at our stop.
- Easter music We will use a recorded piano/organ accompaniment for the first hymn "Jesus Christ is Risen Today." Pastors and acolytes (cross and Paschal Candle) will process from the back. Altar will be undraped. Al Gunderson will lower the black drape from the mural and the two white Easter banners will be brought up and hung during the first hymn. A cantata recording will be played as the postlude. Special music possibility Dan, Candy, and Danilee.
- April 16th (Sunday after Easter) will be themed "Hitting Homers for Jesus." This is a light-hearted service with a baseball theme an Easter laugh/Holy Humor Sunday. Congregation will be invited to dress in baseball attire and we can serve baseball-themed snacks for coffee hour.
